2010 Small Town Pinot Noir

Sonoma Coast, Sonoma County

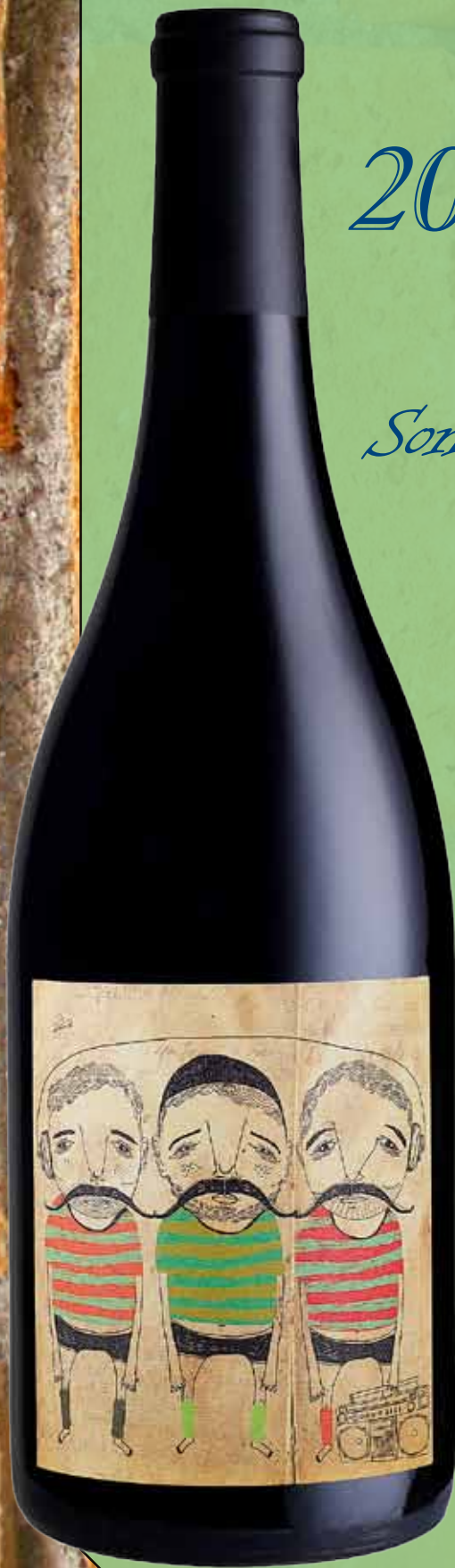
Vineyards: 71% Cleary Ranch & Michael Valentine, 23% Roberts Road, 6% Stiling

Produced: 365 cases produced

Bottled: December 6, 2011

Alcohol: 14.1%

Notes: After a generally temperate growing season, 2010 experienced some famous heat spikes, but the cool area of Freestone was relatively protected. In the end, the vintage produced a dark, full, expansive wine that remains true to its cool-climate roots with an exuberant nose of savory spices, herbs and impressive fruit, carried on by a silky, rich palate of black cherry and wild berry chutney. Perfectly ripe tannin and balancing acidity provide structure and extend the complex and lingering finish long after the sip is over. In short, we're absolutely thrilled with this delicious wine! Already drinking well, the 2010 should continue to improve over the next 4-5 years, and may well prove to be longer-lived than that.
