

**2007 Fritz Windisch  
Haus Brandt  
QbA Mosel-Saar-Ruwer  
Riesling**

**Varietal:** 100% German Riesling

**Appellation:** The Mosel-Saar-Ruwer region. Along the serpentine route of the Mosel river, banks rise so sharply that the vineyards carpeting these slopes are among the steepest in the world, with some planted at an astounding 70-degree gradient. On these precipitous inclines, nearly all labor must be done by hand. That includes tying each vine to its own eight-foot wooden stake, and carrying up the slate soil that has washed down with the winter rains.

**Tasting Notes:** Pale color, fragrant, spring blossoms and green apples on the nose, dry, crisp, refreshing acidity, light body. Great as an aperitif, with salads, white meats and fish.
